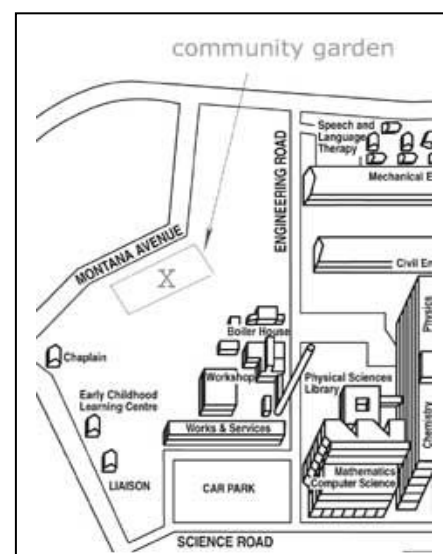
What: Covers Garden Composting, Bokashi & Worm Farms.
